The Bayview Hunters Point Multipurpose Senior Center, Inc is sending this letter of support for the California Pacific Medical Center's Institutional Master Plan. Our center has provided critical services to San Francisco's seniors for the past 33 years. Most importantly, it has enabled hundreds of African American seniors the opportunity of having a safe place to be heard and cared for as they struggle with the challenges of aging. Our work which includes the Adult Day Health Center at 1250 LaSalle, the Senior Ex offender Program and the Multipurpose Senior Center at 1706 Yosemite is strongly supported by CPMC.

In 2007, BHPMMS was awarded a partnership grant from CPMC specifically to assist the needs of frail and aging seniors in Bayview Hunters Point. This three year grant which allocates eighty thousand dollars a year to the center's senior outreach is now in its second year.

The rebuilding of St. Luke's Hospital will provide another option for seniors from our target areas to receive health care services close to home with dignity and respect.
